About the Chief Shark Chef

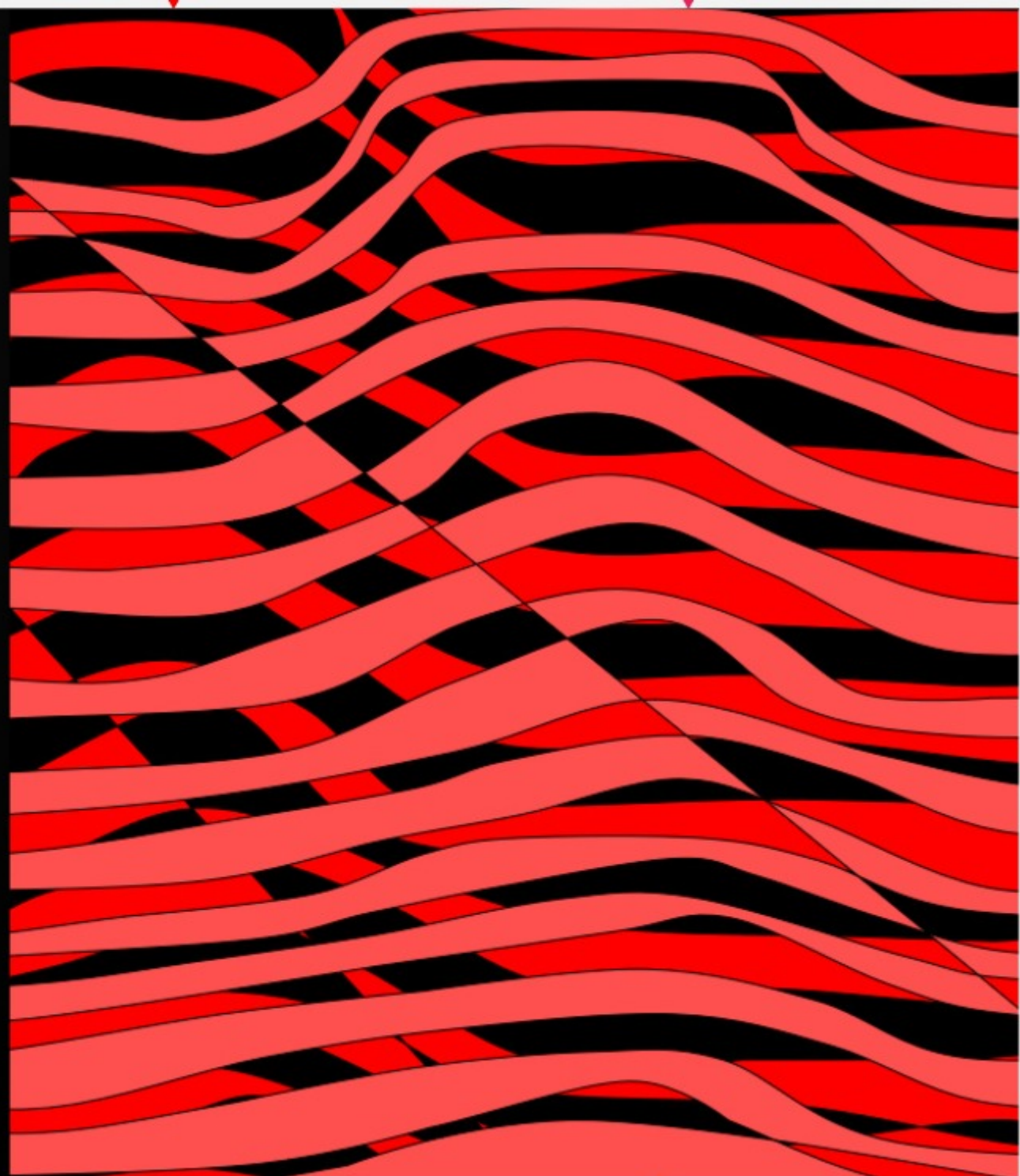
